| <p>ROW MAINTENANCE This is the backbone of care for the garden. Soil and dahlia care activities include weeding, raking, staking and dead heading. Volunteers determine their schedule and activities can be shared with a friend or family members. Ave. time/week: 30 min.</p> | <p>June–October</p> |
| <p>GROUP CLEAN-UP NIGHTS General garden clean up tasks are completed as a group. 2 times per month: 1.5 hours per session</p> | <p>June–October</p> |
| <p>PLANTING AND DIGGING TUBERS 2-3 hour shifts</p> | <p>Late May/Early June & October</p> |
| <p>TUBER CARE Prepare tubers for the spring sale, planting and winter storage. Indoor tasks completed in small groups. Flexible 2-3 hour shifts</p> | <p>April/May & October/November</p> |
| <p>EVENTS Tuber sale: Assist with the May tuber sale. Equinox: Provide assistance with this annual celebration. Community engagement: Help with presentations and collaborate with various local agencies.</p> | <p>May & September TBA per event</p> |
